#### It's Fresno State Corn Time!



Sales of the sweet, fabulous, famous Fresno State corn begin **Monday, May 25** at 8 a.m. at the Gibson Farm Market on Chestnut, just south of Barstow.

Only one family member per group will be admitted to the market to collect corn. Customers must wear face masks and are asked to use sanitizer before selecting corn - and no shucking, peeling, or returning corn to the bins. Corn is 50 cents an ear.

"Corn Only" lines are offered outside the store where you can pick up prebagged corn - 10 ears for \$7. Prepare for a wait - wear a sun hat and bring water. They expect to have plenty of corn through September!
