Education (from an accredited institution or foreign equivalent.): A Master's degree in Business Administration or a closely related field.

2. At least one year of practice experience in finance or a closely related field.

Preferred Qualifications:

Experience:

2. For KAC Instructors: Specialized experience in the topic being taught.

Preferred Qualifications:

Certifications:

A current Physical Education credential is preferred for supervision of student teachers.

Also, instructors of courses offered online are required to be online certified and or take QLT training before serving as an online instructor. 2. Must be able to recruit and retain students
3. Must be able to maintain excellent relations with both public and private educators in the area you are being considered
4. Demonstrated commitment to working effectively with faculty, staff, and students from diverse ethnic, cultural, and socioeconomic backgrounds.
